

Your Home Maintenance Checklist For Fall

Clean gutters and downspouts Keep water draining properly by removing leaves, ensure brackets are secured
Check smoke and carbon monoxide detectors Test every alarm in your home, replacing batteries if needed
Prep heating system for cooler temps Replace HVAC filters, bleed air from radiators, and schedule annual maintenance with a professional
Have fireplace and chimney cleaned and inspected Make sure they check the flue for a tight seal when it's closed to prevent heat loss
Fertilize and reseed lawn Cooler fall weather is ideal for seed germination
Trim trees close to the house Consider hiring a professional to trim branches out of reach from ground level and report limbs close to power lines to local officials
Inspect attic ventilation Make sure eave vents are uncovered to prevent potential ice dams
Prep plumbing for winter Turn off external water lines for hoses and sprinklers; make sure indoor pipes are well insulated
Change summer screens to storm windows and doors Install weather stripping around window and door frames to prevent drafts
